Items in Yellow needed for front-country campouts

BASIC BACKPACKING OR FRONT-COUNTRY OUTDOOR GEAR LIST (revised April 2013)

Gear can be carried in a duffle bag or a backpack to front-country campouts. Try to avoid loose gear so try to get your gear into or strapped to a duffle or pack.

MAP (if issued)

NOTEBOOK
WATCH
WATER FILTER
BEAR BAG (for hanging food)

SCOUT HANDBOOK

in a zip lock plastic bag for weather protection.

SEASONAL CLOTHING

COLD WEATHER

LONG SLEEVE SHIRT
TROUSERS
SWEATER or FLEECE
LONG UNDERWEAR
HIKING BOOTS (ON)
EXTRA SOCKS
WINTER SHELL/PARKA
WARM HAT
GLOVES (2 pr.)
RAIN GEAR! (rain jacket and rain pants)
EXTRA UNDERWEAR
Plastic bag for dirty clothes

WARM WEATHER
SHORT SLEEVE SHIRT
HIKING SHORTS
LONG PANTS
SWEATER/JACKET
HIKING BOOTS (ON)
EXTRA SOCKS
HAT w/BRIM
BANDANA
RAIN GEAR! (rain jacket and rain pants)
EXTRA UNDERWEAR
Plastic bag for dirty clothes

BACKPACK

with
RAINCOVER ON TOP
(can use a heavy-duty trash bag for rain cover)

Small day pack or fanny pack to hold day water and day hike gear

2 MAN BACKPACKING TENT (SHARED WITH ANOTHER SCOUT)

SLEEPING BAG SLEEPING PAD

BACKPACKING FOOD (freeze dried)

(3 MEALS/DAY) plus healthy trail snacks like cheese and crackers, granola, or trail bars)

EATING KIT

Backpacking stove + fuel
PLATE
BOWL
MUG or CUP
KNIFE/FORK/SPOON

CLEANUP KIT

SMALL TOWEL
CAMP SOAP
TOOTHBRUSH
TOOTHPASTE
DENTAL FLOSS
WASHCLOTH

OPTIONAL GEAR

(For Example)

- CAMERA
- BINOCULARS

NOT PERMITTED

- BAGS OF CANDY
- POP
- JUNK FOOD (chips, brownies, candy, etc.)
